SUBJECT

BYLAW 25-02 MUNICIPAL PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVE EXEMPTION FOR NEW NON-RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT OR EXPANSIONS

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the County of Vermilion River give Second Reading of Bylaw 25-02 Municipal Property Tax Incentive Exemption for New Non-Residential Development or Expansions.

THAT the County of Vermilion River give Third and Final Reading of Bylaw 25-02 Municipal Property Tax Incentive Exemption for New Non-Residential Development or Expansions.

Background: This Bylaw was presented at the Regular Meeting of Council on January 28, 2025 where Council requested further information.

Most of the buildings being built in the non-residential sector of the County of Vermilion River are valued at less than \$1 Million. The average, although constantly changing, is in the \$400,00.00 to \$500,00.00 range.
