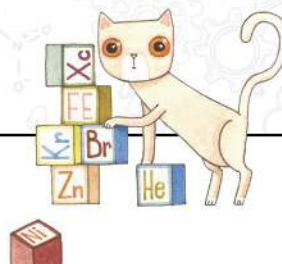

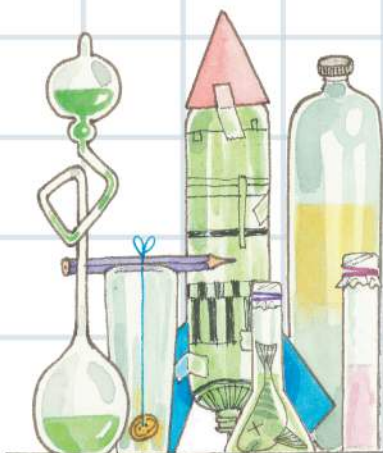

RAVE OPT-IN FOR COMMUNITY WATCH ADVISORIES FROM ALBERTA RCMP

LOGIN & SIGN-UP PORTAL

WHAT IS RAVE?

RAVE is a web based communication platform that RCMP officers are mandated to fan out real time alerts to community members in Alberta. Alerts are operational and educational in nature. They might look like BOLOs (Be On the Look Out), Crime Prevention, Victim Services, and District reports. Alerts are sent via email, text message or phone call – preference is on the account user.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

This communication can strengthen partnerships between volunteers associations and police. Community members can assist police and be a useful resource to their local detachment and their respective community. RAVE will also be a useful educational tool for Crime Prevention and Victim Services information. Information is trusted and received in real time.

RAVE is a web based communication platform that RCMP officers are mandated to fan out real time alerts to community members in Alberta.

Report it online!



YOU CAN FILE A REPORT IF:

- You have lost something that costs less than \$5000
- Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5000
- Someone has vandalized your property or vehicle and it will cost less than \$5000 to repair it
- The crime happened within the jurisdiction of the Alberta RCMP
- Thefts over \$5,000 are accepted from oil, telecommunications, and utility companies



YOU CANNOT USE ONLINE CRIME REPORTING IF:

- There is a witness or suspect
- There are lost or stolen items involving personal identity, firearms, licence plates or decals

All crimes reported online to the Alberta RCMP will be followed up with a phone call from a police officer within five business days.

- Tree stumps
- Waxed paper
- Wrapping paper

Unacceptable Items

- Aerosol cans
- Batteries
- Bricks and cement
- Clothing
- Electronics
- Ink
- Lumber
- Motor oil
- Needles
- Nuts and bolts
- Paint
- Expired medication

**Collection sites in Vermilion for unacceptable items**

- Vermilion Transfer Station or Vermilion Bottle Depot for Electronics, Household Hazardous and Industrial items
- Cornerstone co-op Pharmacy, Long's Value Drug Mart, or Shopper's Drug Mart for Medical items

Roll-Out Bins

- Ensure your bin is placed out correctly on the street by **7:00 am** on your collection day
- One meter of clearance on all sides is required so the automated truck can access the bin
- Refrain from parking in front of your bin on collection day
 - o If there is a vehicle parked in front of your bin, place the bin out past the vehicle so the truck can reach it.
- All waste must be bagged and fit within the bin with the lid closed
- Overflowing bins or bags left beside the bins will not be picked up

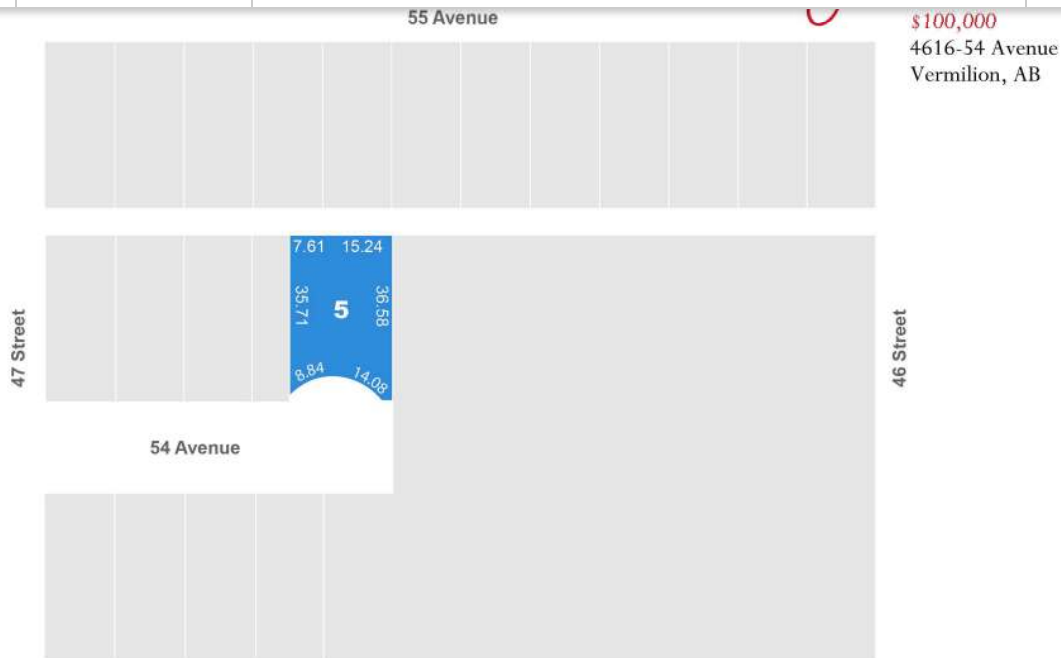
